Objective	Test the candidate's ability to evaluate and manage common cases in everyday practice.
Languages	Danish, Dutch, English, French, German, Greek, Italian, Portuguese and Spanish.
Fee	€ 625,00.
Venue	University Hospital, Health Sciences Campus Gasthuisberg in Leuven, Belgium.

Examination

Format	Pre-recorded exam, taken in 8 consecutive sessions at a PC provided by the EBU. The candidate will be examined on 3 to 5 clinical cases by a minimum of two examiners.
Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• On the day of the exam the examinee registers at the assigned time and place based on information provided beforehand.• Before the start of the session the examinee is guided to the assigned exam room.• The examinee takes the exam under supervision of one examination board member.• Once logged in to the computer, the exam starts automatically.• The examinee is presented the pre-recorded content verbally and is guided to give a verbal response to a specific question.• The responses are given in the same language.• To support the exam process, the examiner may choose to intervene.

FEBU Title	Successful candidates are granted the title Fellow of the European Board of Urology, FEBU.
FEBU Diploma	Successful candidates receive digital FEBU diploma by email; Paper diplomas to be ordered separately and are sent by post.
FEBU revalidation	The FEBU diploma is recognised as a Mark of Quality. The FEBU diploma will be issued for a period of five years and subject to revalidation based on Continuing Medical Education (CME).
